Baked Turkey Meatballs



1 pound lean ground turkey 1 small yellow onion, finely diced

2 garlic cloves, minced

2 cups finely chopped fresh spinach

1 egg

1 cup dry bread crumbs 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese

1 teaspoon red pepper flakes

3-5 dashes of Worcestershire sauce

Salt and pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Line a baking sheet with aluminum foil (or parchment) sprayed with vegetable oil. In a large bowl, combine all ingredients. Mix well with your hands. Form mixture into golf ball or walnut-sized balls and place them on the baking sheet. Bake for 15-20 minutes, turning once, or until golden brown. Makes 24 small meatballs. Serve on spaghetti, baked squash, or on rice with marinara sauce. Or use as an appetizer with a dipping sauce.
